V LIBERIA: A TALE OF TWO WORLDS

In Liberia, life is divided into two groups...those that have, and those that do not. The separation between the two worlds is just as sharp and impossible to cross as the razor wire in this picture.



Some statistics of interest:

- Unemployment is 80%
- The literacy rate is only 20%
- · Half of the population is under 18
- Life expectancy is only 47 yrs
- Virtually no-one has access to electricity, running water, or health care.

The Love Lights The Way Foundation (LLTW) is a non-profit organization dedicated to enriching the lives of the Liberi-

an people. The original members that make up LLTW helped create an existing orphanage called "Christ Children's Home" (CCH) in Gbarnga, Bong County, which has 44 beautiful children full of hope. These children have beds to sleep in, food in their tummies, and loving care-givers that provide for their nurturing, education, health, and spiritual well-being.

In 2011, LLTW purchased 10 acres of land in the Fendell community just 20 minutes outside of Monrovia. Plans are underway to construct an orphanage, clinic, school, guest house (for visiting missionaries), leadership training school, multi-purpose center and church. This village will be for the good of the people in the Fendell community, but will also provide for the continuing education of the children in the future orphanage on this site (as well as CCH) to offer the hope of continuing education after they reach adult-hood (18 yrs old).

As the orphans graduate from their high school studies, they will have the opportunity to move into the Continuing Education section and attend the newly completed University of Liberia's Fendell campus.

Plans for the 1st Building

The Fendell campus is located approximately 20 minutes from Monrovia. Liberia has made a substantial investment in this area by building the new University of Liberia campus here. We purchased 10 acres of land in this area to capitalize on the strategic value of the location, but the population is still very rural, and the villages are small and in need of schools and clinics.

Although we plan to build 6 or 7 different structures on this site (details for those in the next is-



sue), we decided that the most important facility to start with is a Multi-Purpose building. This will eventually become the guest house for visiting missionaries (called "The Lighthouse Inn"). Until all the plans are complete, however, it will serve as temporary lodging for visitors associated with building the site and overseeing its security and other needs.



Who is LLTW?

The founding members of this non-profit organization represent 3 churches in Rhode Island and Massachusetts, and a health-care provider. These four entities have already been partnered for several years in support of a children's orphanage in Gbarnga, Bong County, Liberia. The orphanage, Christ Children's Home (CCH), has 44 children, most of who lost their parents in the terrible

civil war. CCH has an accredited school, full-time staff, clinic, and 3 meals a day. Although LLTW is not providing the day-to-day funding of CCH, the Foundation is now engaged in creating a larger compound that is located near the University of Liberia Fendell campus. And part of our commitment to both the orphans at CCH and the new orphans that will live at our Fendell campus (expected to be 160 at full capacity) is to provide continuing education at the University of Liberia. This will give the children an opportunity at a better life and a better future for Liberia.
