

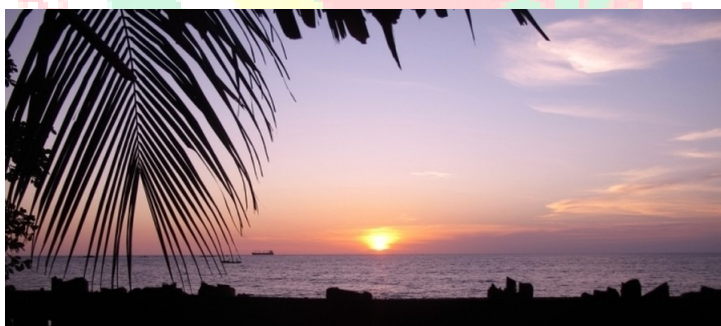

♥ **Groundbreaking Trip a Huge Success!** From January 2012 thru February 2012 LLTW had two teams of workers in Liberia. Their agenda & accomplishments include:

Prepare for groundbreaking ceremony by visiting the site, begin making contact with local residents and government officials to invite them, attempt to get some sand and cement to be able to make some blocks.

*Team 1 completely exceeded all of our hopes and expectations! They hired a crew, cut a road, built a bridge, hired a dozer contractor, cleared land, purchased tools, built blocks, and start building a warehouse. The teams met with and invited dozens of locals and government officials. As final preparations were being made for the meal, itinerary, and cane pavilion, the teams were hoping for 100 to 150 in attendance. We had 250! The warehouse and security residence have been built, are under roof, and can have concrete flooring poured if additional funds can be sent.*



Make a day trip to CCH, and invite them personally to the groundbreaking. We will offer them financial assistance to cover the costs of the trip.



*CCH was unable to attend the groundbreaking ceremony, but they gladly accepted our invitation to visit them. Team 2 visited CCH on Tuesday and spent several hours talking, eating, encouraging, visiting children, and checking out their progress at the new site in Suakoko. On the way back from this all day trip, we were also able to find a sister orphanage, "Safe Home Children Village", in Flelah and meet with their directors. We were very satisfied that we were able to meet some fellow workers in the cause, and encourage each other, and begin to build a network of contacts that will serve us and the church well into the future. Visit the University of Liberia Fendell campus, and attempt to setup a "field trip" visit there with some of the kids from CCH. Although we were not able to take children from CCH, we did visit UL Fendell campus. We were impressed with the enormity of this campus. We are blessed that soon UL will transfer all of its undergraduate studies to this campus, which is less than a half hour from our village.

Obtain quotations from local companies to drill a well on the site. We obtained two quotes for drilling the well and installing a pump. Healing Hands International has graciously agreed to fund the well, and completed the transfer of funds a couple of weeks ago. This is a \$5,500 gift from HHI! At the time of this writing, the well is drilled and the pump complete.

Video-tape "interviews" with various people in Liberia for inclusion into our DVD. We took hundreds of digital pictures, and dozens of video segments. All together, it is more than 25 Gigabytes of data! We will have sent this data to Jonathan Burnett who has agreed to edit the material into a DVD for us.

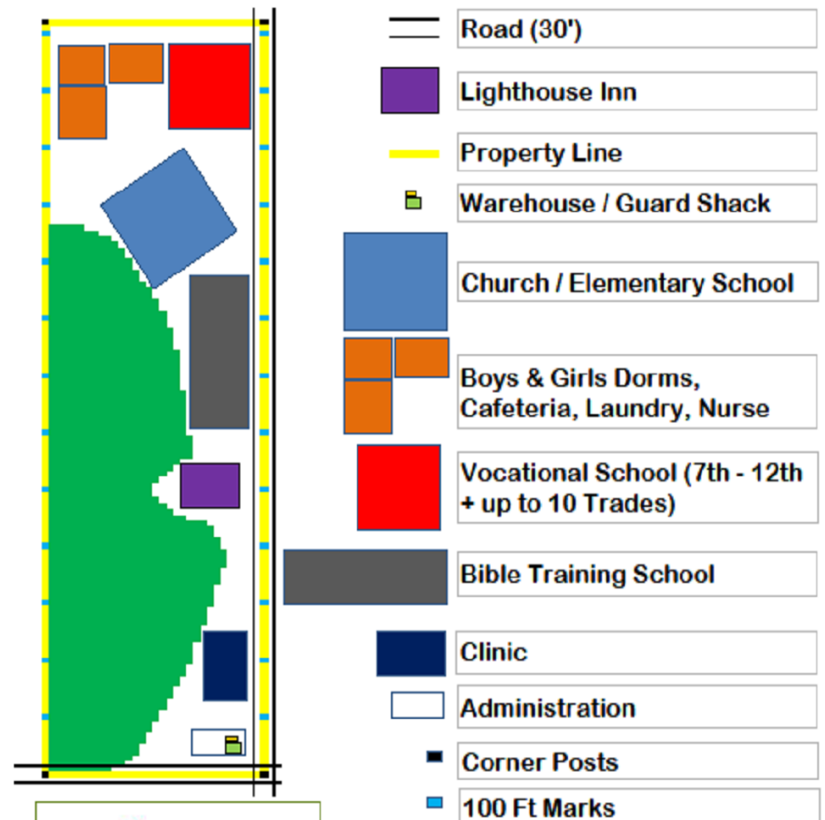


♥ This is an artist's rendering of our first major structure to be built ("*Lighthouse Inn*", a missionary guest house). We are hoping to conclude a successful Calendar Raffle fund raiser, which will enable us to pre-build the concrete blocks necessary for the construction of this building. We want to get the blocks made before the rainy season gets in the way (May and beyond). That will give the blocks plenty of time to cure, and will make construction later in the year go

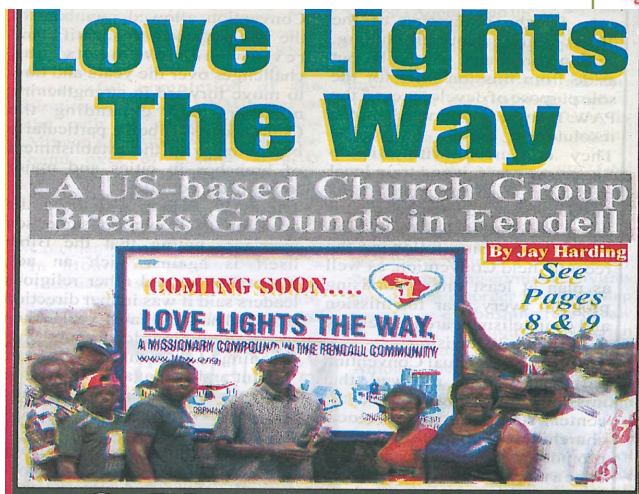
much faster.

We met with an Architect during our time in Liberia, and developed rough draft floor plans of all the buildings planned for this site. To the right is a tentative site plan showing the buildings in their approximate size and location. The green area to the left is sloped land, considered unsuitable for building.

Most of the land has been cleared, but will need some re-shaping and firming up of the borders. It is amazing how fast things can be completed, however, when you have the right people in place. LLTW is blessed to have the right people!
